Again the 4th world class Easter Festival will be held in Andermatt in the heart of Switzerland. As of every year the program offers distinguished chamber music concerts in combination with a choreographed light show supporting the performance of the artists. Enjoy young ensembles that already received prizes in music contests or visit a concert of internationally renowned artists performing some of the top class festival highlights as follows:

Sunday March 25, 2018, 7.30 pm – “Le cor glamooureux”

The magnificent opening concert of the Festival Strings Lucerne together with Ivo Gass, multiple awarded solo french hornist of the Tonhalle Orchester Zurich, is certainly one of the festival highlights and is hosted by Sabine Dahinden of the Swiss Television SRF.

Tuesday March 27, 2018, 7.30 pm – “Hommmages Romantique”

The Belenus Quartet is a very promising Swiss quartet with young musicians instrumentation. They already have participated successfully in various music contests and in extraordinary music projects. Pianist Yulia Miloslavskaya will join the quartet – an aspiring concert pianist which studied at the Conservatory of Moscow and the University of the Arts, Zurich. Enjoy the very special performance of “Hommmage Romantique” by these young music talents.

Wednesday March 28, 2018, 7.30 pm – “Classic meets Folklore”

With the concert “Classic meets Folklore” we invite you to works by the Alder Dynasty performed by the renowned folkore artist Nicolas Senn and Trio Fontane. Hear how the price awarded Swiss artist elicits classical style from his hammered dulcimer. Comissioned work composed by Nicolas Senn will be premiered on this evening.

Thursday March 29, 2018, 10 am – “Education school concert”

The Easter Festival supports, as every year, education with a school concert by inviting students of the canton of Uri. The Hexagon-Ensemble Lucern performs “St. Paul’s Suite” by

Gustav Holst. The commissioned piece "Suworow's Odyssey" by Rushton Dagny Edward will be premiered at the evening concert.

Friday March 30, 2018, 7 pm – "Crucifige eum"

The Festival Strings Lucerne and chorus Audite Nova Zug will perform on Good Friday the Passion concert of G.F. Händel's "Messiah" in english language, conducted by Johannes Meister.

Saturday March 31, 2018, 7.30 pm – "The Devil's Bridge"

The Swiss Piano Trio will also premier the commissioned work "The Devil's Bridge" by Daniel Schnyder together with renowned solist Fabio di Casola on Clarinet. Two more works by Swiss composer Paul Juon, born Feb 23, 1872, deceased Aug 21, 1940, will be performed.

Sunday April 1, 2018, 7.30 pm – "Resurrexit"

One more time the Festival Strings Lucern will brilliantly play festive music from the baroque era featuring solists Otto Sauter, trumpet, Carmela Konrad, soprano and Maya Ando, piano. Works composed by J.S. Bach and G.F Händel.

Monday April 2, 2018, 7 pm – "Brass festival"

In the final concert of the classic Easter Festival you can indeed expect a "classic fire work". The World Brass ensemble is one of the most renowned brass ensemble of its kind and their goal is to entertain the audience on a high quality level representing various music styles from Baroque to Classic and to Jazz...
